Dear Relatives and Friends

Given that COVID-19 situation continues to change on a regular basis we wanted to remind everyone of the following requirements for visiting an aged care facility.

**Please do not visit loved ones if you or someone you live with:**

- has any symptoms of COVID-19
- are awaiting a COVID-19 test
- are required to self-isolate for any reason
- has returned from a designated hotspot within Australia within the last 14 days
- has returned from overseas within the last 14 days

If you answer no to all of the above points, there is no requirement in relation to the number or the length of visits. However, we ask that you only visit during the facilities visiting hours (check with our reception staff if you are unsure of the visiting times) and ensure proof of a current flu vaccine is provided. In addition, prior to entering a Residential area please ensure:

- temperature is taken;
- sign in book is completed providing a contact number;
- hands are sanitised;
- communal areas remain free of visitors; and
- Government's social distancing requirements are applied.
