## New Government Regulations

From the 6th December 2021, anyone coming into an aged care facility in South Australia will need to provide proof of having received two doses of an approved COVID vaccination. We have attached the letter that was sent out to all relatives and representatives earlier this month. Please read this carefully and ensure that anyone who is likely to visit one of our facilities understands this new Government requirement.



## What Are We Doing To Keep Everyone Safe?

We have now negotiated another Commonwealth vaccine clinic at Seaton and everyone is invited including:

- **The small number of Residents** that have not had the opportunity to receive either the first or second dose. We will contact you over the next week to organise consent if you or your loved one falls into this category.
- **All Residents that require a booster shot.** We will distribute consent forms for the booster shot to you or your loved ones very shortly.
- **Anyone who visits or would like to visit** someone who calls The House of Saint Hilarion or the Villa Saint Hilarion home. This includes anyone who is eligible for the first, second or booster shot. If you would like to take advantage of this opportunity, please phone reception during business hours on ph: 8409 1500.

## Other COVID News

The COVID Leadership Group has been working hard to ensure that we keep everyone as safe as possible. In particular, we are:

- reviewing our pandemic plans;
- requiring all staff to undertake further training on COVID and infection control;
- ensuring staff stay at home and receive a COVID test if they have any symptoms whatsoever.

- are required to isolate for any reason
- are awaiting a COVID test result

When you do visit one of our facilities, please:

- only visit during visiting times;
- have your temperature checked;
- provide proof of a current flu vaccination (if you haven't already done so)
- check in on our QR code and sign in and out in our visitors book;
- always wear a mask unless eating, and
- stay out of communal areas.

**Importantly, if you have any concerns that after visiting you or anyone you have been in contact with has any symptoms whatsoever, please let us know immediately.  
You can call the facility day or night.**

We are very excited to announce that our Saint Hilarion Recipe Book now available.


### Thank You to Everyone at Melbourne Cup Lunch


